

# 2021-2022 CME & MOC Activities Guide

The American Psychiatric Association (APA) offers a number of educational initiatives that provide highquality and innovative continuing medical education (CME) for psychiatrists and other mental health clinicians with the ultimate goal of advancing patient care. Please see below for a list of CME activities that assist APA members and the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology (ABPN) diplomates in meeting Maintenance of Certification (MOC) requirements.

APA reports CME and MOC completion data on behalf of our members directly to ABPN, however, diplomates are still required to log on to their <u>ABPN Physician Portal</u> at least once per calendar year to attest to completion of their MOC activities. #### MOC Part 1- Professional Standing (Licensure)

To show evidence of professional standing, all board-certified physicians must continuously hold an active, full, and unrestricted license to practice medicine in at least one state, commonwealth, territory, or possession of the United States, or province of Canada. Full details of licensure requirements can be found in the General Information and Board Policies publication on the <u>ABPN website</u>. Licenses must be kept up to date in an <u>ABPN Physician Portal</u>.

The APA Patient Safety Education and Quality Improvement course will enable physicians to learn essential knowledge, skills and attitudes about safety that they can then apply to their own clinical environment. This program is intended to provide the foundation for a new culture and new practices through education on various topics required by the ABMS and some additional areas of interest. ### MOC Part 4- Improvement in Medical Practice (PIP)

The APA's PIP modules are guided practice improvement programs created for psychiatrists and are designed to meet Part 4 MOC requirements for clinical modules. PIP Modules follow a three-stage Performance Improvement CME structure that takes place within a 24-month period. Psychiatrists can earn up to 20 AMA PRA Category 1 credits<sup>™</sup> for the completion of each 3-stage module.
